Tags on the Shelf

Print price labels and bin tags in Rundoo. Everything starts in POS → Products, and a bin tag is just the floor name for a price label.

THREE WAYS TO PRINT

1

One label

A smudged tag, a new SKU, a moved display.

[Open the product](#) → [Print label](#)

2

A whole batch

A shipment landed or a section needs refreshing.

[Check rows](#) → [Print labels](#)

3

After a price change

The one you'll reach for most.

[Filter](#) → [Select all](#) → [Print labels](#)

Print a batch in 3 steps

- 1 In POS → [Products](#), [Search](#) or [Filter](#) to the items you want.
- 2 Check the row boxes (or [Select all](#)). A blue bar appears at the bottom.
- 3 Click [Print labels](#), pick a template, set copies each, and [Print](#).

What prints**Tier 1 retail price**

Barcode is always on. A painter or custom price and your [cost](#) never print on a tag.

[Reset labels](#) is not "[clear selection](#)." It reprints the checked items with their last template and quantity, no window. To clear a selection, click [Clear](#) next to the count instead.

[Print in Chrome](#), and match the template's label size to the roll you loaded, or tags come out sideways or shifted. Designing the tag itself is the next video, [Design Your Own Label](#).
